EA Lot Size Guide

Managing leverage/risk is critical to your success in forex trading. We try to "pound" this concept into our Pro Members. Our suggested risk level is 1 mini (10k) lot per \$5000.00 of equity in your account (per system). The RT (Round Table) EA can be run with less than our suggested levels since we rarely have more than 2 live trades running at any given time.

Using less than \$5000.00 per mini lot with our X System EA's will result in a margin call or worse. The reason; each X System EA can potentially open up to 17 live trades at once (2 EA's x 17 live trades = 34 live trades). You must leave enough "wiggle room" in your account for draw down and margin.

Note: You need a minimum deposit of \$1500 to run all 3 systems at the same time (using 1 micro lot).

Micro = Micro Lot or \$0.10 per pip (each pair has a different pip value)

Mini = Mini Lot or \$1 per pip (each pair has a different pip value)

Stand = Standard Lot or \$10 per pip (each pair has a different pip value)

Do not increase lot size if/when you turn off currency pairs. Turning off currency pairs can increase over-all performance, but it will not change our suggest deposit and/or Lot Size levels. Over-leveraging WILL result in a margin call or complete loss of account equity.

At most, you should reset your lot size and leverage once per quarter. We recommend adjusting your lot size and leverage once per year. Do not scale your lot sizes or stack leverage. The math does not work. You will completely wipe out your account. Stick to our suggested lot sizes and leverage levels.
